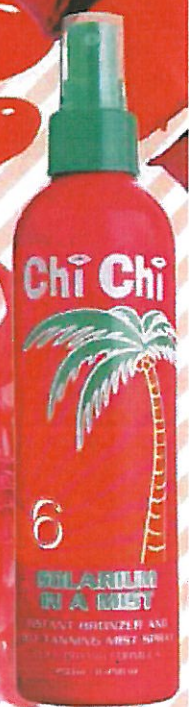

Fringe dwelling

Q I recently got a fringe and when I wake up in the morning it's a mess! How can I style it so it actually looks nice?

A So, it's Camilla-like bangs you want, but without the mad-morning hair? Done. Just listen up and learn from the pro: Julie Zavaglia, owner of Glow Salon in Sydney (02 9247 2233)

- ✓ To start, spray the root area with water – when it comes to styling your fringe, it's always best to start with wet hair
- ✓ Choose a hair dryer with a fine nozzle as this helps direct the air flow and keeps the hair cuticle flat, creating shine.
- ✓ If you have a cowlick, forget the brush, instead point the dryer nozzle straight down so that your hair dries flat.
- ✓ If you're cowlick-free, start from the centre and use your brush as a guide rather than to shape (so your hair doesn't curl around it). Use a medium ceramic barrel brush and dry in the natural direction to keep shape longer
- ✓ Finally, avoid heavy hair product that will only weigh your fringe down and grease it up. A light spritz of hold spray or a little smoothing serum will suffice.

1 Too Faced World Domination Collection. \$69 (toofacedcosmetics.com.au). This is any makeup junkie's fantasy, a one-stop case of literally every colour cosmetic you need - all packaged up in a music box. That actually works. Apparently Chrissy wishes do come true.

2 Philosophy The Tiki Hut. \$69 (meccaacosmetics.com.au). Mecca's got a lovely bunch of coconuts... or at least coconut-scented treats. More edible than a Bounty chocolate bar, this pack includes a three-in-one shower gel/bubble bath/shampoo, body butter and a lip balm.

3 Clinique Happy-To-Go Solid Perfume Pencils. \$45 (clinique.com.au). We're not easily impressed but, by golly, we were downright bowled over by these nifty pencil-esque perfume solids. Handbag and pencil case friendly, one is the original "Happy" fragrance and the other two are the key Happy notes - flowers and citrus.

4 Estee Lauder Makeup Traveler Set. \$69 (esteeclauder.com.au). If you're after old school glamour, this is it in a compact. A combo of blushes, lippies and shadows, it's so timeless you'll be using it till you're 80. Plus it comes with a set of brushes and a makeup case just to sweeten the deal.

5 David Jones Boudoir Chic Jewelled Make-Up Palette. \$24.95. Another pretty palette (but this one is kinder to our cash flow). It's sparkly, shiny and has everything you need for summer shadow, gloss and a bronzer.
